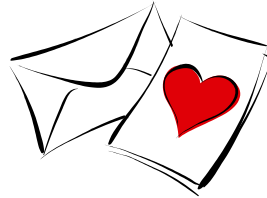

FINANCIAL SPONSORSHIPS



We ask our communities to help us with the sponsoring of the RESIDENTS who will come to participate with us in a multi-denominational 3-day weekend.

Prison residents participate in hearing the gospel message proclaimed. We supply food, drinks and support materials which amount to an expense of approximately \$150.00 for each resident for the weekend. We ask individuals and all the groups in our churches (the BODY)-4th Day groups, Sunday School classes or departments, fellowship groups, prayer groups, etc. to consider the verses in James 2 as you think about helping us bring the message of Jesus to those behind bars, so that they may be set free in Christ as we have been set free through him.

In the past, members of the teams have had to bear all of the costs. But Kairos in Texas has rapidly expanded and is now serving 48 TDCJ units. You can be a partner in the further expansion of Kairos in Texas by your financial sponsorship of a resident.
