

4 COOKIES

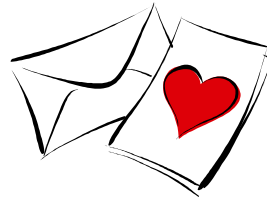

These cookies should be about 2 1/2" to 3" in diameter cooked full of prayer and prepared, then packaged, so as not to stick, crush or crumble. Team Membership

Jesus tells us in Matthew 25:36 that it is our responsibility to visit those who are in prison -“I was in prison and you came to visit me.” In Matt. 25:39-40 we read “When did we ever see you sick or in prison, and visit you? The king will reply, I tell you when you did this for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did it for me!”

One of the ways you can go into the prison is by being on a Kairos team. We ask that you make yourself available and God will provide the necessary abilities and blessings.

FINANCIAL SPONSORSHIPS



We ask our communities to help us with the sponsoring of the RESIDENTS who will come to participate with us in these multi-denominational 3-day weekends.

Prison residents will hear the gospel message proclaimed. We also supply them with food, drinks and support materials which amount to an expense of approximately \$150.00 for each resident for the weekend. We ask individuals and all the groups in our churches (the BODY)-4th Day groups, Sunday School classes or departments, fellowship groups, prayer groups, etc., to consider the verses in James 2 while thinking about how to help us bring the message of Jesus to those behind bars. With this message, they may be set free in Christ as we have been set free through him.

Previously, members of the teams have borne all of the costs. But Kairos in Texas has rapidly expanded and is now serving 48 TDCJ units, so we need extra partners. You can be a partner in the further expansion of Kairos in Texas by your full or part financial sponsorship of a resident.
